4. If you receive any paychecks in the mail from your employer, real estate investments, pensions, social security income, consider switching to direct deposit so no payments get missed.

5. Take pictures and record video of the rooms in your home and any valuable belongings.

6. Make sure your "Go Bag" has extra copies of your photo I.D. as well as important contact information of family members.
